Mandatory use of face masks

Purposes and legal basis of the data processed

The processing of your personal data serves to protect against serious cross-border health threats, including communicable diseases such as SARS-CoV-2. In this context, we base the processing on Art. 6 para. lit. f, Art. 9 para. 2 lit. i DSGVO, § 22 para. 1 no. 1 lit. c BDSG-neu.

Categories of recipients of personal data

We only transfer your data to third persons (including public authorities) as far as we are legally obliged to do so.

Processing outside the EU or the EEA

Processing outside the EU does not take place.

Duration of data storage

This information will be retained by DEKRA for the duration of the incubation period of COVID-19 and deleted three weeks after signing the form, provided that statutory retention periods do not prevent deletion.

Your rights**General rights**

You have a right of access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, opposition to processing and data transferability.

Rights relating to the processing of data to protect a legitimate interest or in the public interest

Under Article 21 paragraph 1 of the DPA, you have the right to object at any time, for reasons arising from your particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning you, which is carried out on the basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 letter e DPA (data processing in the public interest) or Article 6 paragraph 1 letter f DPA (data processing to safeguard a legitimate interest). In the event of your objection, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can prove compelling reasons for processing worthy of protection that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.

Right to complain to a supervisory authority

You also have the right to complain to the competent data protection supervisory authority about the processing of your personal data by us.
